Why are we protesting?

- The Director of Tax Research at HMRC estimates £95 billion is lost to the public purse each year through corporate tax evasion & avoidance. This could pay for a huge number of the public sector services. The budget deficit the cuts will try to recoup is **£155bn**.
- A source within HMRC claims Vodafone owe between **£4bn and £6bn** in unpaid tax.
- Philip Green runs Topman, Topshop, BHS, Wallis, Outfit, Dorothy Perkins, Burton & Miss Selfridge. In 2005 he avoided paying **£285m** in tax by running it through an off shore bank account. It could have paid the fees of 32,000 students or pay the salaries of 20,000 NHS nurses.
